













THE RED RAP

A developed nation in terms of strong GDP and Per Cpatia Income without Enlightened Citizens is a dangerous proposition. One of the critical components to measure the degree of englighthenment is the reading habit of its citizens. The figures in India aren't very encouraging and that is a major concern for all of us. A cumulative analysis of last 3 years studies shows that an average Indian in Urban India reads ONLY around 30 minutes per week. The lack of detailed reading trends itself is a reflection on the priority reading has in our country.








- We have 10333 Registered Readers with Registered ID cards across India. Each of the reader has a specific ID and when books are issued they are tagged to this reader / book lover.
- Renewed focus enabled the 6187% jump on this dimension
- 100% of current Book Lovers / Readers come from the Schools
- 51% of the current Book Lovers / Readers come from this South state and second highest readers come from North state with 21%










- We have build and operating 125 Libraries across India in various formats ranging from School to Mobile libraries (reCYCLE)
- All the Libraries have signed MoU with the Foundation agreeing upon a standard operating procedures for issuing books and maintaining records
- Each of the library is tracked on READER Index to study the impact at the Micro (Grass root) level in terms of qualitative impact it is making in children / book lovers / reader lives







- We are operating in 19 States and Union Territories in 57 cities across India in a short span of 3 years of operations.
- The sustained focus on spread the wings has resulted in almost 100% jump on year on year basis in geographical spread
- We have grown equally across pan India ranging South to up North East and J&K
- Region wise the spread is as follows South 48%, North 16.8%,












- Saving Stories / Folklore / Cultural Heritage has been one of the core goals of foundation.

- We are ready with the next 100 stories but the progress on this dimension has been relatively slow because of lack of budgets / sponsors for converting the stories in the digitised format.

















- Brining idle books to re-life is one of the core objectives of the foundation and we are extremely proud and happy to share that we have been extremely successful on this front

- All of these books have come as donations by book lovers ranging from the age group of 8 to 80 and we have around xx language books and magazines in our libraries












